<u>Monday 4th August</u> The Royal British Legion are having a nationwide event to mark the outbreak of WW1. It is entitled '**LIGHTS OUT**' and will be between 10pm - 11pm.

A meditation by candlelight will be held at St. George's Church at this time for anyone to come and reflect on the 100th anniversary of the outbreak of WW1, quietly for a few minutes or an hour.

#### PARISH WW1 COMMEMORATION

The Parish Council has organised a brief civic ceremony as a contribution to the commemoration of the centenary of the start of World War 1. It will take place on **Monday 4 August at 7.30pm in the village cemetery**. It will be a 'commemoration' only of a historic and cataclysmic event that profoundly altered the world and affects us all, even today and is not intended as a memorial or to replace the annual act of remembrance that takes place in November. The event will be purely civic, secular and inclusive having no religious, nationalistic, accusatory or triumphal content so that nobody should feel that they are excluded by reason of faith or none, denomination, nationality or conscience. It will consist of prose and poetry readings, the speaking of the names on the war memorial and any others who people wish to be commemorated, the planting of a tree and the sounding of "Last Post" and "Reveille". Please do come and speak the name(s)

you are commemorating at the appropriate time or if you can't do that but would still like names spoken give the details to any Parish Councillor beforehand. It is stressed this is not a religion led event; everybody is invited and welcome.

# Friends of St Georges Church.

The Cream Teas in the Churchyard proved to be very popular, even on the wet Saturday of 28th. June, when it was Teas in the Church! The two events together raised just under £400. So thank you all for supporting us in our efforts to raise money towards the World War 1 memorial plaque restoration.

The First World War memorial plaque – by the time you read this, the plaque will be down in Surrey being restored. The firm carrying out the work have just finished a project for the Imperial War museum, so we are in good hands. Interestingly, when we removed it from the wall in the Church, we found the names of the two men that fitted it on 28th. February 1921, M.J. Raymond and W.M. Gifford. We will add a small note next to them as a record of the refurbishment, for someone else to find in another 90 odd years! Fundraising for the work is going well with some very kind donations either given or promised, in addition to the generous grant offered by the Parish Council and our own fund raising efforts. Sadly our efforts to obtain money from regional and national organisations have been less successful, so this really is a 'Village Effort' . Thank you all very much . <u>This message came through eCops</u> but everyone needs to be aware of this sort of Scam

There has been a recent report that a person in the Huntingdon area has been contacted by telephone by a company saying they are carrying out a survey on behalf of the Council.

They knew their name, address as well as their telephone number and wanted to make a house visit. The person did not agree to anything and rang the County Council's Customer Contact Centre to check if the call was legitimate.

One of the Council's Officers then rang the Company back and pretended to be responding to an earlier call.

The Council Officer was asked a large number of questions about his lifestyle, which papers do you read? To which he replied The Guardian, do you have a Conservatory? do you have a mortgage? and this continued for approximately ten minutes before the Council Officer terminated the call. During the questioning he was told that some of his answers meant he could be in for a cash prize with details to follow. Almost immediately after the call was terminated the Council officer was telephoned by another Company wanting to sell him a subscription to the Guardian newspaper.

Please be aware of the above when receiving calls and the County Council have stated they do not make calls asking questions or information of this kind. These scam companies pass on your details to others (without your permission) and it is highly unlikely that there is a cash prize to be won.

#### **Parish Council**

At the June meeting the Parish Council agreed to donate £200 from S137 funds towards the cost of the renovation of the WW1 Memorial plaque in St Georges Church.

The Local Highways Improvement Initiative costings for the work at the A10 junction were received and it was agreed to contribute a maximum of £430 for this work. (This bid was to move back the kerb just past the bus stop so that when there is a queue of cars at the A10 junction those wishing to turn towards Stretham can get through to the slip road so lessening the queue.)

Councillors are currently compiling a list of trees that they consider an amenity to the village – this is in addition to the trees with a Preservation Order on them.

A number of people have raised concerns about hedges and undergrowth coming on to the public footpaths – this makes it especially difficult for push chair and wheelchair users and residents are asked to keep their hedges trimmed if they run alongside a public footpath please. The clerk is to write to the responsible body about the hedge in Greenhill and the Electrical Substation in The Wyches.

Notification has been received from UK Power Networks about laying an underground power cable from Ely to Soham.

Amended plans for the construction of a detached dwelling behind No 19 Main Street have been considered. The amendments seemed to address the previous concerns and it was agreed to recommend approval.

At the July meeting Councillors heard about New Standing Orders to be considered, received a report from the Internal Auditor and the consultation to reduce the no of Councillors from 9 to 7. There is to be a review of polling district, places and polling stations. The John Townsend Audited accounts were received and notification of a pilot Parish Conference.

The clerk was thanked for her finance work following the internal auditors report.

The clerk was asked to contact the Sports & Social Club with regard to their intention to build a skate ramp for the children of the Village to remind them of resident's concerns regarding Risk Assessments and Insurance when the PC were trying to undertake a similar project.

The next meeting of the PC is August 18<sup>th</sup>.
