Little Thetford Parish Council

At the October meeting correspondence was received concerning the trees in the cemetery – East Cambs. District Council's Tree Officer has been contacted for advice.

The clerk confirmed that she was unable to get replacement parts for the cradle swing in the Play Area and she was asked to order a new seat and chains. Cllr Russell has over the autumn trimmed back the hedge growth and he and Cllr. Bullen have repaired the soft surface where it had deteriorated. An additional seat is being researched for this area.

Following a number of complaints contact was made with the Rights of Way and Access Team at the County Council about the state of the Fen Rivers Way due to the cows grazing on the river bank. At the November meeting the Councillors were pleased to welcome Mr. Kai Stoeber as a Councillor to fill one of the PC vacancies. One vacancy remains and interested parties are reminded to contact the clerk. Cllr. B. Hunt attended and gave an update on both County and District council matters

Research into a possible site for a BMX style track and other items for the over 10's continue.

A Planning Application for Popes Corner Marina was considered and it was agreed that the PC's response would be to be guided by The Environment Agencies views. It was agreed to recommend approval for the Planning Application for a loft conversion and separate garage/gymnasium at Berrycroft, Red Fen Road. Following a request it was agreed to send a £50. donation to MAGPAS.

It was noted that the Waterbeach - Ely and return bus service is to be partially re-instated.

Memorials to be sited on graves in the cemetery were approved.

The Precept for 2013/14 was set at £14,000 grass cutting, maintenance, insurance and general running costs the main focus for the increase.

An additional bin for dog waste has been ordered to be sited in Holt Fen.

Residents are reminded that the contents of the salt bins are there for their use on the roads – not private property. Salt should be spread very sparingly when needed.
