Parish Council.

A brief additional meeting was held in August to consider a planning applications for new vehicular and pedestrian gates at 1 Green Hill this was recommended for approval. An appeal to the Secretary of State for the proposed development to the rear of 2 Main Street was considered and it was agreed to repeat the previous comments. At this same August meeting it was agreed not to proceed with the temporary BMX style track on Holt Fen – the weather at the beginning of the school holidays had prevented this being built and it was not now viable for the time left.

The September meeting heard a report from Cllr. Hunt covering a number of County Council topics one of which was the speed reduction to 50mph on the A10 through Lt Thetford. From the District Council he reported that the issue of parking charges is ongoing and that the existing Leisure Centre Activities will be maintained until an alternative can be built.

A good number of members of the public were present. Issues raised centred around activities for young people. Concern was expressed that children had been seen playing on the railway tracks and on the partially sunken boat at the river. (The boat has been reported to the Environment Agency several months ago) The Play Facilities Working Party reported on their research so far and it was agreed that the PC would have a site meeting again on Oak Field other options would continue to be researched both for this and a Youth Shelter and they would also be looking into grant funding and further public consultation.

It was agreed to adopt the new model Code of Conduct, amend the standing orders accordingly and delegate the power to grant dispensation to the clerk. Councillors need to complete a new Register of Interests form. The Jointly Funded Minor Improvement Bid to have some additional signage and road markings in the village in line with the Parish Plan has been successful. The PC will be contributing 10% of the cost - £140. The oak tree by the Lt. Acorns Pre-School has had a Tree Preservation order placed on it.

Following concerns raised by residents P.C.S.O. Annie Austin had walked around the village one evening accompanied by two Parish Councillors the focus had been on parking while nothing untoward was noticed that evening it was noted that cars parked on pavements should allow room for pushchairs and wheelchairs

to pass without having to step off the path.

The next Parish Council Meeting will be on Monday October 8th 7:30pm in the Village Hall.
