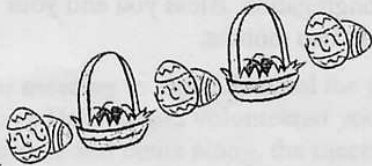

## Little Thetford Parish Council.

Grasscutting Contract for 2010 for the areas which the Parish Council have responsibility was awarded to MJS Gardening Services. The salt bin for Holt Fen has been delivered and sited. It was recommended that an application to extend a house in Main Street was approved. Lt Thetford Acorns Pre-School and Children's Club were awarded a grant towards the cost of information technology equipment in their new building. The Parish Council have decided to join the Parish Paths Partnership to access resources for footpath issues raised in the Parish Plan. A Working Party of Councillors have been investigating funding to improve the Play Area and to make some provision for older children. The PC approved their plans for the Play Area and applications have been made for grant funding. Funding research into provision for the older children continues. Conflicting results from the Parish Plan and a survey done by ACRE regarding Affordable Housing in the Parish was discussed, Parish Plan comes out against it, Councillors agreed to support the views in the Parish Plan.

## PARISH PLAN.

An open meeting to move forward the issues raised in the Parish Plan will be held on April 8<sup>th</sup> at 7:30pm in the Village Hall. If you volunteered your time and energy to help with any of the issues do make a note of the time and date and come along, the meeting is open to all residents – so if you didn't make a commitment at the time but are interested now you will be very welcome. Could you help with a village Spring Clean – did you offer to help with Conservation work, are you interested in activities for older people or re-instating the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme or designing a leaflet about footpaths? All these issues and more can be progressed with your support so do come along.
