The Friends Of St. George's

The Friends Of St. Georges was set up over 20 years ago as a group of villagers who wanted to see this historic building maintained and kept in good repair. There are close ties with the Church's governing body, the Parochial Church Council, but you do not need to be a regular church go-er to join us. Over the years we have raised many thousands of pounds to pay for improvements and repairs to the Church. At the moment we have a list of repairs totalling £17,000 which we hope to start on this summer. As the building is so old keeping it in good order for future generations is a never ending task

and we must continually think of ways of raising funds and at the same time providing events for folk to attend and enjoy the beauty of the building. In June we had our Flower Festival when we celebrated Village life in the 20th. Century, many thanks to all the people who worked hard to ensure the success of the event and those of you who came along to enjoy the sights and smells of the arrangements. The home made cakes were pretty good too ! As always, Mike Petty's talk on the Saturday night was a great success, there really is nothing that Mike doesn't know about this area and it really is a great pleasure to have him come and speak to us with his wonderful selection of pictures and anecdotes. The weekend raised £600, which is a pretty good figure until you realise that repairs to just one window are going to cost ten times as much !

On 15th. July, twenty two of us welcomed the Rev. John Sansom back with his wife Judy, so that we could have another 'Brush with the vicar'. John is now retired, although he still officiates at the Cathedral from time to time, and this gives him more time for his painting. He really is a most accomplished artist and kept us spellbound as he painted a landscape whilst all the while explaining the techniques that he was using, how certain colours fooled the eye, and how important it is to use good materials. The end result was so well received that he has offered it to us for auction. Many thanks John. The evening raised £115.
