Sustainable Community Strategy

Following the first consultation phase, the East Cambridgeshire Strategic Partnership (ECSP) is now developing the new Sustainable Community Strategy, for launch in April 2011.

The feedback received during phase one of the consultation $(1^{st} \text{ March} - 20^{th} \text{ May } 2010)$ provided the Partnership with information which organisations and members of the local communities felt to be of importance in East Cambs.

As a result, the Partnership has now produced a draft new Strategy which will replace the existing Sustainable Community Strategy for 2008-2011 and will run for 20 years, from 2011-2031.

This new Strategy sets out how services can be improved and delivered to increase the environmental, social and economic well-being of the district and will act as an overarching partnership plan for East Cambridgeshire.

Lt. Thetford Parish Council

The Annual Parish Council Meeting was held on May 10th when Cllr. Bullen was returned to the office of Chair and Cllr. Staines as Vice Chair. Appointments were made for two members of the Council to act as representatives on the Village Hall Committee, & The Conservation Group. A representative was also appointed to the Neighbourhood Panel.

A report was heard from Cllr Bill Hunt, County Councillor covering the possibility of a weight restriction on the A132 through local villages, the plans to build a new Village College in Littleport, a parking review in Ely, a possible new Railway Station in Chesterton etc. Concern had previously been expressed about footpath no 3 being blocked, this had been reported to the Rights of Way Officers and it is understood a 'kissing gate' is to be installed. The P.C. are in the process of adopting the telephone kiosk, which means the telephone box will stay but we loose the telephone – BT reported that it had only been used twice in a number of months. This meant that the village was likely to loose the box so it is to be bought for the village for a nominal sum – future use to be decided.

The year end accounts and Annual Return were presented and agreed.

A short report was made from the April meeting of the Neighbourhood Panel. The first piece of equipment for installation on the Play Area and funded by The Big Lottery Fund has been ordered and should be installed by the end of June. This is a wheelchair and buggy friendly roundabout from Park Leisure. If we are successful with a further bid for funding there are further improvements to follow.

An additional meeting was held in May to consider a planning application in Holt Fen. Future dates for Parish Council meetings are June 14th and July 12th at 7.30pm
