PARISH COUNCIL

At their meeting in December Councillors had a discussion with Mr. Ian Dewar of CAPALC regarding the wayleave in Holt Fen. At their January meeting when a resubmitted application to ECDC for permission to erect four dwellings on land in Holt Fen was considered, Parish Councillors had no objections and decided to wait until the Planning Authority's decision before seeking further professional advice on the possible

An application to the Planning Authority for a change of use and siting of 8 traveller's pitches on land in Stretham Station Road was considered by Parish Councillors who decided that as the site was outside the Parish they would make no objection but agreed to endorse the views of a parishioner whose land might be affected by the plan which he had submitted to ECDC. The District Council's direct workforce continue monthly inspections of the childrens' play area and to effect minor repairs as appropriate. Attendance to a slightly worn rope on the rope walk and

impaired rotation of the roundabout will be requested from the manufacturers. It is understood that the tenants of the 'old football field' in Red Fen Road currently let for grazing do not intend to renew the contract when the present one expires. Councillors considered a number of possible future recreational uses for the site although no decision was taken. Anybody who might be interested in leasing the field on the expiry of the current agreement may obtain further details from the Clerk. The highway authority is to be requested again to make repairs to the white line road markings at the A10 corner as an urgent safety matter. Councillors are unanimous that the future planning and organisation of the extension to the cemetery requires professional expertise not possessed by the Clerk; membership of a professional body from which it is hoped suitable advice will be obtained is to be sought. Councillors feel this is particularly necessary in the light of recent difficulties experienced with two interments (happily satisfactorily resolved), the lawful requirements on Parishes for the correct management of cemeteries and the 'old' cemetery reaching capacity imminently. In December Councillors carefully considered a proposed budget for 2016/17 having regard to known and anticipated future expenditure and the expected reduction in the level of District Council services that would need to be met by the Parish if the status quo is to be maintained. Notwithstanding all those considerations at the January meeting Councillors agreed a 'break even' budget and the Parish precept on Council Tax for 2016/17 will NOT be increased
