PARISH COUNCIL

The Parish Council had no need to meet in August. At its meeting on 8 September Councillors agreed to make a bid to the Cambridgeshire County Council minor highways improvement scheme to have the cycle path towards Ely upgraded. Some amendments to the cemetery regulations were agreed: an addition is the banning of motor vehicles and trailers from the cemetery except for a mini-digger for the purpose of digging graves; charges will be increased by £10 for parishioners and £20 for non-parishioners, no charge will be made for the interment of a child under the age of 12 years; the Clerk will use her discretion where residential status is unclear. Approval was given to an application to erect a new headstone that complied

with the guidelines. The latest model of "Standing Orders for Local Councils" (which has only minor alterations to that adopted in 2010) was adopted with an amendment that the chair of the Parish Council, who is elected on an annual basis, may not hold office for longer than 4 years (previously two.) The Clerk was instructed to chase up the long standing order for a new dog waste bin in Cowslip Drive and to report the overdue alteration to the street lighting on a telegraph pole in Main Street to the contractors and our District Councillor. Councillors will continue to exchange the rubbish bin bag in the children's play area and maintain, on a strictly voluntary basis, the conservation area as appropriate when their time and the weather allow. Councillors learned that a planning application for a wooden structure to provide a granny annex and garage at the rear of "The Acacias", Ely Road, to which no objections had been raised by the Parish Council has now been withdrawn by the applicants. A short presentation was received from ESACT (Ely & Soham Association for Community Transport) – was "Dial-a-Ride" - on its new formation and services offered. Some details are shown in the parish noticeboard and leaflets are in the information kiosk and at the weekly post office. Also shown now on the parish noticeboard are the contact details of the Parish Clerk, Mrs. S. Thompson. In future she will normally (as far as her other parish duties allow) be in her office to take telephone calls on Tuesdays from 8.30 to 9.30am. and Fridays from 3.30 to 5pm. Should parishioners wish to contact the Parish Clerk at other times they should leave a telephone message on 01353 666385 or Email: ltcouncil.clerk@btinternet.com The next full meeting of the Parish Council is on Monday 12 October.
