Little Thetford school

Last term was very busy but, as always, lots of fun and excitement.

The children enjoyed shopping for their Christmas presents and were able to make £6 buy gifts for their family and friends with enough for a treat for themselves - a great day was had by all!! The infants and the juniors performed well in their Christmas shows and both the parents and the teachers were very proud of all the children. The parties were lively and enjoyed by everyone – even Father Christmas didn't want to miss out and called with gifts for the infant children. A quiet, reflective church service was the perfect ending to our Autumn term.

Both the children and staff have quickly settled into the new term. Already we have had a whole school trip to the pantomime at Bury St Edmunds which was very noisy and lots of fun. Years 3 and 4 have a residential trip to Burwell House planned where they will develop their knowledge and understanding of Victorian life. Burwell offers a safe learning environment where the children can relax and develop their independence and is a wonderful place for children to experience their first trip away from home!

Later in the term years 5 and 6 will visit Kingswood in West Runton. The children experience adventure activity sessions such as riding on a quad bike or whizzing down the zip wire. Specially trained instructors help the children to excel in a supportive environment and the teachers are often surprised by what they achieve.

The infants hope to visit the Museum of East Anglian life to learn more about school life during Victorian times. This is going to be another term full of so many enrichment opportunities for our children.

Parish Council

The January Meeting began with a welcome to Cllr. Sue Hampton who was co-opted to fill one of the vacancies. Cllr Ann Wardle has resigned as she has moved from the Parish and details of the process to fill that vacancy are on the PC Noticeboard. Cllr Wardle is thanked for her term of office with the PC. The meeting was informed that the planning application for a new dwelling to the rear of No 40 The Wyches has been withdrawn. In December the meeting was informed of a planning application to change the use of land in Ely Road for the storage of building materials. The PC expressed their concern about additional traffic entering and leaving the site directly onto the A10.

Two new benches have been delivered to provide additional seating in the play area and Holt Fen. These will be installed when the weather improves.

The questionnaire about youth activities in the Parish led to the Parish Council contacting the Connexions Bus Project to invite a representative advise on how this Project might help establish some youth work in the Village. Sadly the representative is not able at present to commit to a meeting because of ill health. Hopefully we will have further information shortly.
