CAN WE HELP YOU?

Brief examples of what the Charity could give assistance for can be read in the policy guidelines on the parish notice board near the play park or pick up a leaflet from the Information Kiosk. A phone call, email or letter to the Charity's Clerk would determine if your cause was eligible. Each application received is considered on its merits by the Trustees at a duly convened meeting that excludes the public and press. In some cases, applications are subject to the financial status of both the applicant and the Charity. If approved, a grant would be offered as a one-off payment only. A further request on other occasions would require the completion of another application form.

PARISH COUNCIL

Following the resignation of a Parish Councillor due to relocation a vacancy is arising for a parishioner to be co-opted to the Council. There is a legal process to be administered and the required notices are displayed on the Parish Council noticeboard. Interested parishioners should contact the Parish Clerk.

A vacancy is also arising for a Parish Council nominee to the board of Trustees of the John Townsend Charity. Notices are on the Parish noticeboards and further information may be obtained from the Clerk to the John Townsend Charity. (See separate article for contact details.)

Following continuous pressure from the Parish Council supported by District and County Councillors, the highways authority has made some improvements to the white lining at the A10 junction. Following representations from the PC the County Rights of Way authority has built new bridges over the ditches crossing **Footpath 3** which is being realigned some 15 meters to the north east.

Discussions are still ongoing with ECDC regarding possible transfer to parish ownership of the playground and the open space in New Close Road.

A presentation was made to the Local Highways Improvement Scheme for traffic calming measures in Red Fen Road. Although details are not yet to hand it is believed that the application was successful. Discussions with officials will continue.

A contract for the renewal of the fencing to the playground was entered into with the local contractor who cuts the grass and it is anticipated that the work will commence after the Easter holidays. It may be necessary to close the playground for a while during the work on safety grounds.

The Parish Council's response to the latest consultation phase to the District Plan was submitted to the Authority and Councillors continue to monitor the process to ensure the best possible outcome for the village. "Future Development of the Village" will be included in the agenda for the Annual Parish Meeting on Wednesday 26 April at 7.30pm. in the village hall. The land adjacent to the cemetery and the car park remains one of the two preferred sites for development under the District Plan. Many Parishioners

have asked about the intentions for the site now that it has been part cleared of growth but the Council is unaware of the owner's intentions and has not been informed about any planning application to date. The Planning Authority (ECDC) has refused permission for the erection of a new dwelling in Red Fen Road and it is understood that an appeal to the Secretary of State has been made against the

Authority's refusal of a planning application for an extension and alterations to 38 New Close Road. Parish Council meetings are open to the public and held on the second Monday of each month in the Village Hall at 7.30pm. or as notified on the Parish Council noticeboard where the agenda is displayed.
